MEMORANDUM FOR NON-DOD FEDERAL ORGANIZATIONS

Subject: Call for ESTCP Proposals

The Environmental Security Technology Certification Program (ESTCP) is the Department of Defense (DoD) demonstration program for environmental technologies. The ESTCP Office is interested in receiving proposals from other Federal agencies for innovative environmental technology demonstrations that address DoD requirements.

The Program Announcement provides details regarding the program's objectives, proposal submission requirements, the evaluation of proposals, and the individual topic areas. The Program Announcement is posted on the ESTCP web site at www.serdp-estcp.org/Funding-Opportunities/ESTCP-Solicitations.

Awardees under this call for proposals will be selected through a multi-stage review process, including a brief pre-proposal, a full proposal, and an oral presentation. Based on the pre-proposal evaluation, each of the pre-proposal submitters will be notified as to whether ESTCP does or does not request the submission of a full proposal. Pre-proposals must be received no later than 2:00 p.m. Eastern Time on Thursday, **March 15, 2012**. Instructions for submittal can be found on the ESTCP web site.
